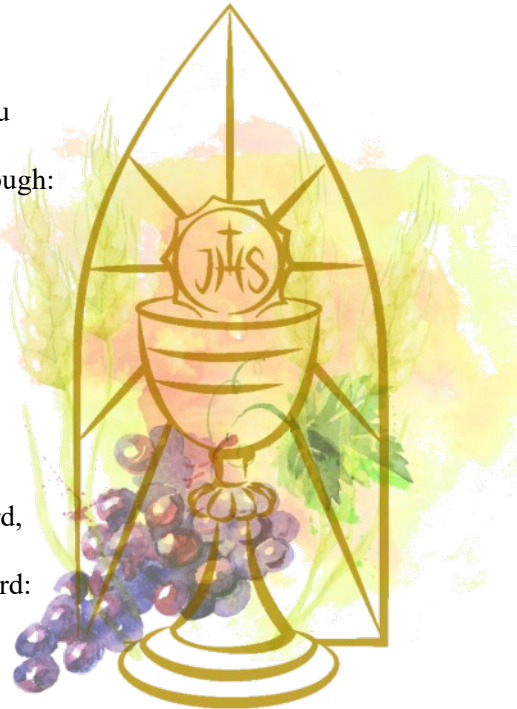

who died for us

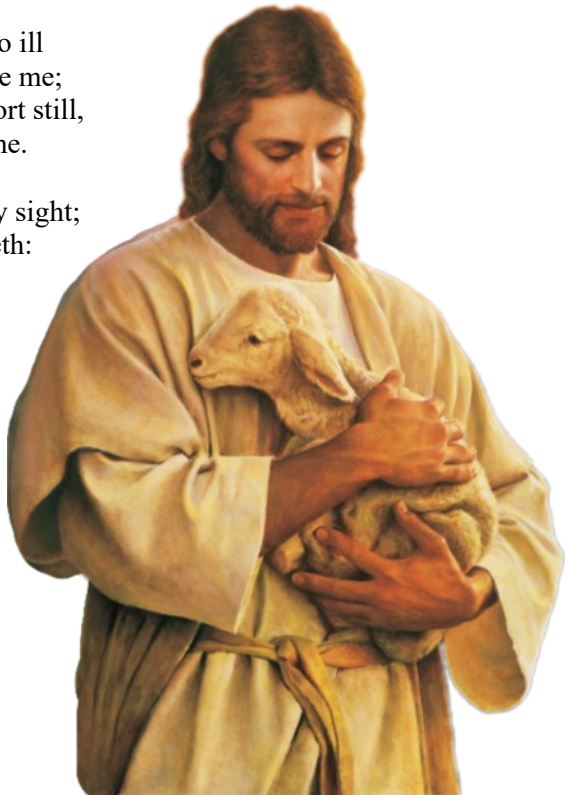


3 This water I give you
