- 5 Love one another, I have loved you serve one another, and when you do do it in love for me.



- 6 Glory, to the Word of justice, Glory, to the spirit of peace.Glory, to the God of love whose blessings never cease!




- Love Divine, all love excelling, Joy of heav'n, to earth come down; Fix in us Thy humble dwelling, All Thy faithful mercies crown.
